

# Lee College: Cost of Attendance

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of what it will cost a student to attend Lee College for a given academic period (Fall, Spring, and Summer). The COA includes tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, transportation, loan fees, and personal expenses. The COA will vary depending on your current status (i.e., in-district, out-of-district, out-of-state) with the college. For students with dependents, the COA will increase by \$1,000 per dependent up to four dependents.

The Cost of Attendance at Lee College Huntsville Center is taken from an average of all program total costs to included pertinent fees. As per the Revised Second Chance Pell requirement, Lee College can only have attributes of Tuition and Fees and Books and Supplies.
