## Refund Policy Comparison

Students on Federal Financial Aid who drop all their classes in a term are governed by two refund policies. The school's policy applies to tuition and fee charges (not all fees are refundable). The R2T4 federal policy applies to how much Federal Financial Aid (Pell, FSEOG, Stafford Loans, PLUS loans) a student has earned at the time they dropped all their classes. Refunds are made to the DOE or lender. State programs like TPEG, TEXAS Grant and TEOG are not affected. Once $60 \%$ of the semester has elapsed ( 66 days in our examples) the student has earned or is allowed to keep 100\% of the financial aid posted to his account. Effective on 7/1/06 amounts the student owes back to the financial aid program that do not equal or exceed $50 \%$ of the original amount posted to the account will not have to be paid back by the student.

## Example 1

A student receives $\$ 2000$ in a Pell Grant and drops classes at various times through the semester. The student has been charged $\$ 500$ for tuition and fees.

A student receives $\$ 2000$ in a Pell Grant and drops classes at various times through the
semester. The student has been charged $\$ 500$ for tuition and fees and $\$ 1000$ for books were charged to her account.
