Application for International Travel Scholarship

Criteria Needed to Apply

- 1. A 2.0 GPA is recommended.
- 2. Student must still be enrolled at Lee College at the time of travel

Exceptions can be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Scholarship Application Packet Should Include:

- International travel scholarship application
- Signed health disclosure form
- Proof of insurance (either your medical insurance card, proof of travel insurance offered by the travel company, or temporary insurance, which is available on a per diem basis)
- Clear photocopy of your driver's license (optional)
- Clear photocopy of your passport, F-1 Visa, or any other mandatory documentation required for you to travel out of/into the U.S. (Note: Passport cannot expire within 6 months of travel dates)
- Signed handbook participation agreement
- Current class schedule
