#### Definitions:

**C**. Average Course Load is the Duplicated Headcount divided by the Unduplicated Headcount, and it shows, on average, how many courses students take per term.



**A**. Unduplicated Headcount: The actual number of individual students enrolled. A student enrolled in more than one course in an academic term is counted only once for the term.

**B.** Duplicated Headcount: Duplicated headcount is the number of classroom seats that were filled. A student enrolled in three courses in an academic term will count as filling three classroom seats for the term.



## **Part 3: Academic and Technical Course Success Rates**

Tables 3a & 3b shows the duplicated headcount in academic and technical courses respectively and the success and withdrawal rates for each course. The bottom rows provide a comparison of IMPACT Early HS dual credit student to dual credit students in all ISD's combined and to non-dual credit students and are not in the Prison Education Program.
