Special Admission Requirements for Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) Major Specific:
Admission to the School of Music is contingent upon admission to

Texas State, successful completion of the audition process, and available space in each studio. Moreover, a successful audition does not automatically ensure acceptance to the School of Music at Texas State. Degree Requirements

Hours required: a minimum of 120 semester hours, 36 of which must be at the 3000/4000 level, and fulfillment of all degree requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree as specified in the "General Requirements" in the Academic Requirements section of the Texas State University 2024-2025 catalog.

General Requirements:

- The general education core curriculum courses are listed in the degree plan below along with the statewide component code number. See the [General Education Core Curriculum](#) section of this catalog for the Texas State requirements and options in the core curriculum, including Honors courses.

- In addition to the general education core curriculum requirements, the [Bachelor of Arts degree](#) (B.A.) requires three additional hours of English literature, three hours of math/science/logic/computer science courses, six hours of 2000-level modern language courses and a minor.
- Students must select a minor from the approved list of [Undergraduate Minors](#).
- Piano Proficiency (Level II)
- Theory Proficiency
- Upper Level Competency Review (ULCR)
- All B.A. and B.M. music majors must participate in the appropriate major ensemble for their instrument each semester until all major ensemble requirements for the degree have been completed. No more than one major and one secondary ensemble will be counted toward the student's degree plan per semester. While not required in the degree plan, continued participation in major ensembles after degree requirements are completed is encouraged.

- Foreign Language Requirement:** a) Students must send an official high school transcript documenting two years of a single foreign language earned in high school, b) send an official college transcript documenting two semesters of a single foreign language from another college, OR c) complete two semesters (or the equivalent) of a single foreign language at the first-year level at Texas State University. (NOTE: Transfer students are now automatically determined to have satisfied the foreign language proficiency requirement at Texas State University)

General Information: Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences with a major in Applied Arts and Sciences at Texas State University.

This degree program allows students who have earned an Associate of Applied Arts or Sciences from a two-year institution to complete a Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences with a major in Applied Arts and Sciences.

Special Admission Requirements for Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) Major Specific:

- Academic Advising: Once a student is admitted and signed up for New Student Orientation, they can call 512.245.1490 to schedule their academic advising appointment.
- Courses evaluated as Vocational Education (VOCED) are not computed in the transfer grade point average (GPA). VOCED courses will not be used for admission purposes.
- Your academic advisor and the Department of Organization, Workforce, and Leadership Studies at Texas State University will determine the applicability of the student's A.A.S. degree upon admission.

Degree Requirements

Hours required: a minimum of 120 semester credit hours, 36 of which must be at the 3000/4000 level, and fulfillment of all degree requirements for the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences degree as specified in the Texas State University 2024-2025 undergraduate catalog.

Major Requirements:

1. OCCUPATIONAL EMPHASIS MODULE (47 Hours)

This module may be satisfied by credits earned from prior learning assessment (work/life experience, non-collegiate sponsored instruction, credit by examination), transfer work from other accredited institutions of higher learning or technical & vocational college credit. Forty-seven hours required, to include OCED 3350 and OCED 4350 courses.

2. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT MODULE (24 Hours)

Professional development sequences are individualized to students' educational needs. Students will choose advanced level courses from at least three academic departments related to future career goals. This module of 24 hours constitutes the major for GPA calculation purposes.

3. CAPSTONE MODULE (6 Hours)

The BAAS Capstone is a two-sequence course that students take in their final semester of the BAAS degree. The two courses are taken in the same semester. OCED 4360 is taken in the first 8-week session, OCED 4361 is taken in the second 8-week session. Students cannot be enrolled in more than 12 hours in their final semester.

4. ELECTIVE MODULE (1 Hour)

A minimum of 120 hours toward the degree, including 36 advanced hours. All additional hours should be chosen in consultation with the Texas State academic advisor.

5. State of Texas Core Curriculum: 42 hours. Students are required to complete the core curriculum for the bachelor's degree. Core courses completed and transferred to the university will be applied to the degree. Any remaining core areas not completed at the time of transfer will need to be completed in consultation with the Texas State University B.A.A.S advisor.

Notes while attending Texas State:

- While PHIL 1305 or PHIL 1320 are strongly preferred, the department will allow other Language, Philosophy, and Culture Component Code 040 courses to satisfy this requirement.
- Biology advanced electives are 3000-4000 level Biology courses.
 - Biology advanced electives cannot be chosen from: BIO 4305, BIO 4402, BIO 4403, or BIO 4408.
 - BIO 4299 requires faculty and departmental approval; to apply as an advanced biology elective, students must take BIO 4299 two times in succession.
- Students may apply only one course from [BIO 3421 or BIO 3426] towards the biology major requirements

Degree Requirements

Hours required: a minimum of 121 semester hours, 36 of which must be at the 3000/4000 level, with 24 of the 36 major applicable, and fulfillment of all degree requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree as specified in the "General Requirements" in the Academic Requirements section of the Texas State University 2024-2025 catalog.

General Requirements:

- Students must select a minor from the approved list of Undergraduate Minors. The recommended minor is Chemistry or Biochemistry. Minor and electives should be chosen in consultation with the academic advisor.
- The minimum number of hours required for this degree program is 120. The number of free elective hours a student will complete depends on the number of hours a student may need to achieve the required 120 total or 36 advanced hours.
